#### Introduction

The Rajasthan Enterprises Single Window Enabling and Clearance (Amendment) Act, 2020 was enacted on 16.09.2020 for strengthening the existing Single Window Clearance System (SWCS) by establishing "One Stop Shop" (OSS) facility in Bureau of Investment promotion (BIP) to facilitate large investment proposals more effectively and expedite requisite approvals / clearances for the same under one roof. Rules for the One Stop Shop has been notified on 26.11.2020.

RAJ NIVESH portal provides a single point (online) interface and a time-bound clearance system by acting as a one-stop information/ registration/ approval/ tracking centre for clearances/approvals.

In addition, the portal provides an electronic-based transparent system for online submission and tracking of applications including e-Payments. It will also provide updated information relating to relevant Rules, Regulations, Orders and Policy initiatives and Schemes for guidance of investors.

#### **Key Features**

- 1. One Stop Shop offers clearances from 14 Departments & around 130 Services under one roof
- 2. Defined timelines for each service, ensuring time-bound approvals under the Rajasthan Guaranteed Delivery of Public Services Act
- 3. Integrated grievance redressal system to address and resolve investor concerns promptly.






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#### **Impact**
